## **Premier 18-hole golf destination will soon be reality!**

Due to the popularity of the Golf Course and the area, Northern Meadows will expand to accommodate the increasing traffic. This next phase features construction of the back nine, expanding recreational community with additional recreational properties, as well as overnight accommodations. The new nine features a mixture of settings. Fairways cut out of boreal forest will challenge your accuracy, while wide-open holes over gently rolling terrain allow you to swing your driver freely. Made up of three par 3's, three par 4's, and three par 5's, the par 36 back nine will offer many opportunities to shoot a low score, but be careful, water hazards should cause you to think carefully on a few holes. Once the par 72 course is complete NMGC expects to host several competitive golf tournaments. Additional properties offering prime views will more than triple the size of the existing Recreational community. Tentative opening is summer 2006.
